It's time for our **18**th **annual Thanksgiving Dinner Program**. Last year, with your help, we prepared and delivered about 200 meals; this year we are planning to deliver over 300 meals to people throughout our community and surrounding areas on Thanksgiving Day! In the hustle and bustle of our own lives it may be hard to imagine that there are those who may not break bread with family or friends on Thanksgiving or who are simply unable to prepare meals on their own, but many of these individuals are elderly or have physical limitations and might spend the holiday alone. We will do our own small part to help fill this void.

We are asking for your help with this impactful project by making monetary donations to be used to purchase items for these special holiday meals, like pies and side dishes. In the past, our Salem Preschool families have donated various canned goods and non-perishables to be used in the preparation of the Thanksgiving meals. This year, because of COVID-19, we sadly cannot offer the same opportunity and will rely on cash donations to purchase the supplies we need.

The cost of each meal is about \$8, but to the recipients, these deliveries are priceless. Every donation helps; we are grateful for your support – be it for one meal or ten—as we achieve our goal of raising \$2,800.
